Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light (FPL or Company) requests confidential classification of certain information filed in Docket No. 20250001-EI, dated May 2, 2025.

The Company is claiming confidentiality of its filing under Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S. Per the Statute, propriety of confidential business information includes, but is not limited to: Subsection (e) "[i]nformation relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information."

More specifically, the information at issue relates to claimed proprietary and confidential technical information regarding a third-party's (to FPL) analysis of electric plant equipment. FPL asserts that disclosure of this proprietary information would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information.

Staff has reviewed the Company's information and confidentiality request. It is staff's opinion the request meets the criteria for an extension of confidentiality contained in Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S.
