Item 21 is a joint petition by Florida Public Utilities Company and Florida City Gas seeking approval of tariff changes to standardize and align the companies' transportation service programs, and for approval of a flexible gas tariff for Florida City Gas.

The companies are not proposing any rate changes at this time. Instead, the parties state this petition is an ongoing effort to eliminate inconsistencies and to standardize their individual transportation service programs.

Staff has reviewed the proposed tariff changes and flexible gas tariff and believes that they are reasonable, therefore, staff recommends that the Commission should approve the proposed tariff changes and FCG's proposed flexible gas service.

If approved, FPUC's tariffs will be effective 30 days from the date of the Commission vote.

For FCG's tariffs, the company has requested that they will notify staff of the final
