- The Utility also requests a repression adjustment to both water and wastewater to account for the decrease in water usage upon which water and wastewater rates are based as a result of the increase in water and wastewater rates.

- 4. The Utility is requesting recovery of costs associated with Hurricane Milton incurred in 2024, but paid and recorded in 2025 (Wastewater)
 - Invoice from US Water Services Corporation to prepare for the storm and post storm pumping: \$12,542.10
 - 5 year amortization, amount to be added to expenses for 2024: \$2,508.42
- 5. The Utility is also asking recovery of the following pro forma expenses for accounting consulting services to ensure financial records are stated adequately in compliance with NARUC, and to review certain financial records for compliance.
 - Milian, Swain & Associates, Inc. estimated total cost \$5,000
