EFFLUENT REUSE - The use of wastewater after the treatment process, generally for reuse as imigation water or for in plant use. (Section 367.021 (6), Florida Statutes)

EQUIVALENT RESIDENTIAL CONNECTION (ERC) - (WATER) - (Rule 25-30.515 (8), Florida Administrative Code)
