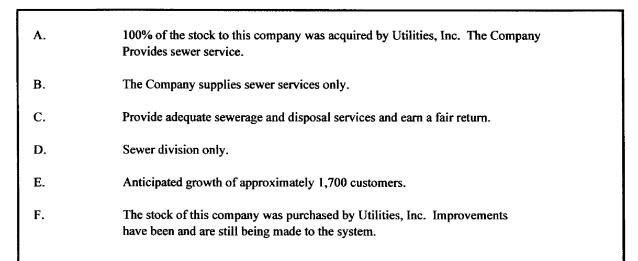

PARENT / AFFILIATE ORGANIZATION CHART

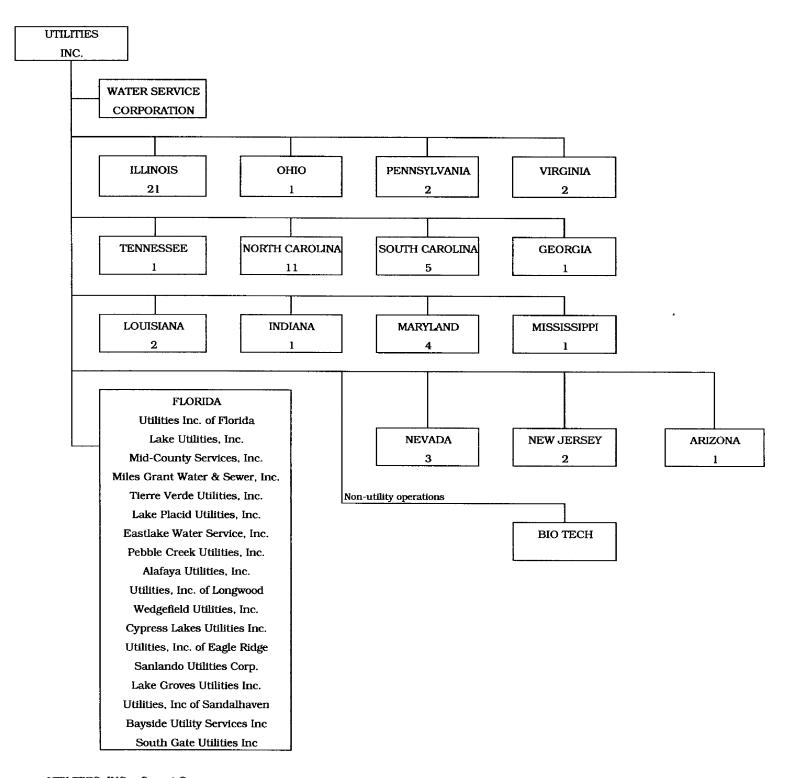
