GENERAL DEFINITIONS

EFFLUENT REUSE - The use of wastewater after the treatment process, generally for reuse as irrigation water or for in plant use. (Section 367.021 (6), Florida Statutes)

EQUIVALENT RESIDENTIAL CONNECTION (ERC) - (WATER) - (Rule 25-30.515 (8), Florida Administrative Code.)

- (a) 350 gallons per day;
- (b) The number of gallons a utility demonstrates in the average daily flow for a single family unit; or
- (c) The number of gallons which has been approved by the DEP for a single family residential unit.

EQUIVALENT RESIDENTIAL CONNECTION (ERC) - (WASTEWATER) - Industry standard of 80% of Water ERC or 280 gallons per day for residential use.

GUARANTEED REVENUE CHARGE - A charge designed to cover the utility's costs including, but not limited to the cost of the operation, maintenance, depreciation, and any taxes, and to provide a reasonable return to the utility for facilities, a portion of which may not be used and useful to the utility or its existing customers. (Rule 25-30.515 (9), Florida Administrative Code)

LONG TERM DEBT - All Notes, Conditional Sales Contracts, or other evidences of indebtedness payable more than one year from date of issue. (USOA)

PROPRIETARY CAPITAL (For proprietorships and partnerships only) - The investment of a sole proprietor, or partners, in an unincorporated utility. (USOA)

RETAINED EARNINGS - This account reflects corporate earnings retained in the business. 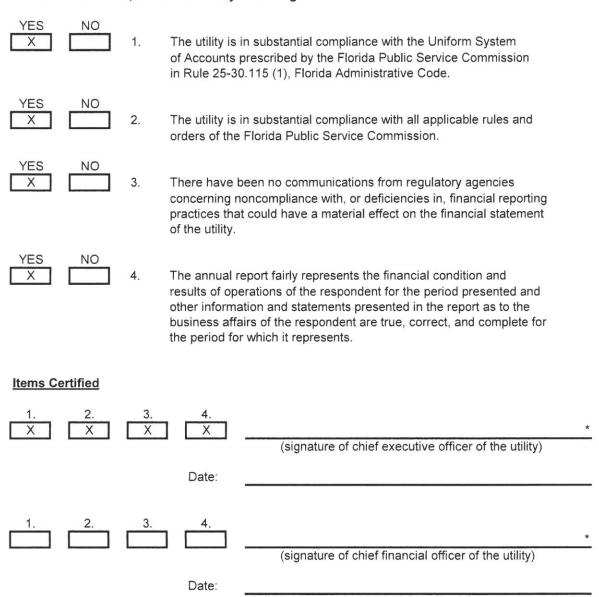
