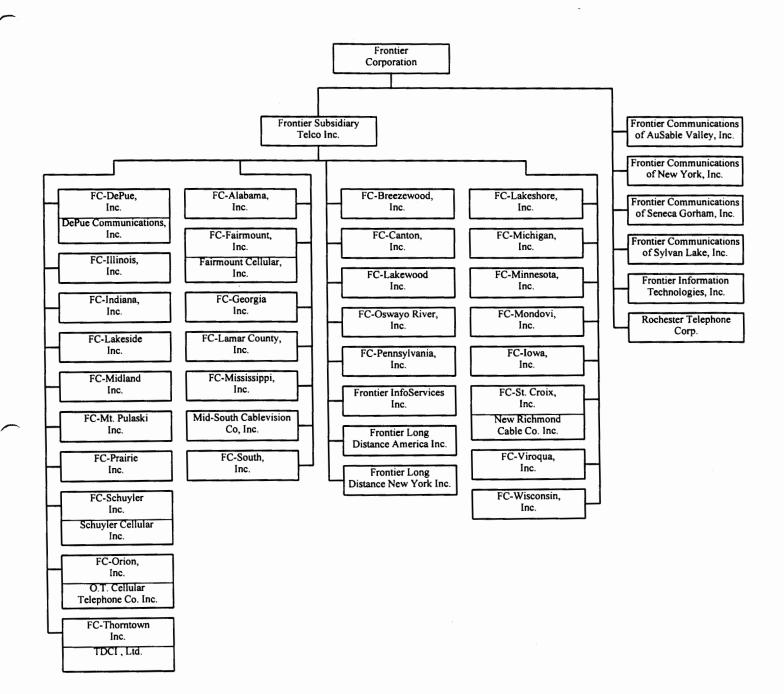

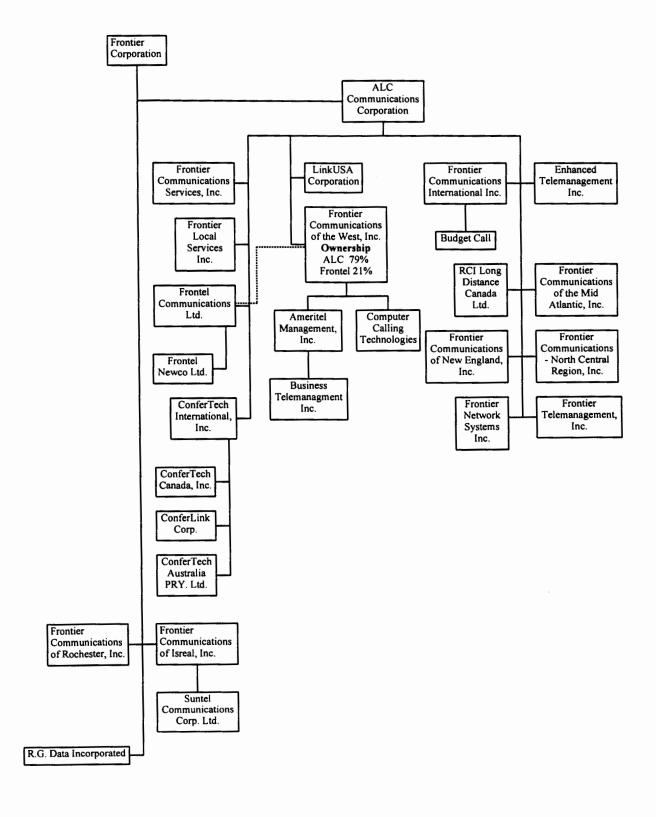
Telephone Operations and Other Entities as of March 23, 1997 (AASTELCO.opx) [FC=Frontier Communications]

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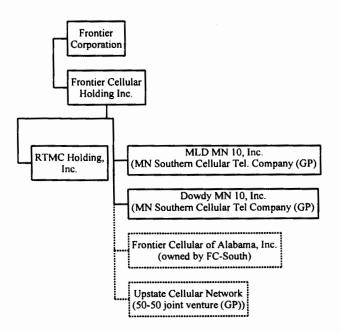


Long Distance Organization as of March 23, 1997 (Longdis.opx)
