Placid Lakes Utilities was established in 1970 to provide water service to the subdivision of Placid Lakes. The company currently serves approximately 1470 residential, commercial, multi-family and general service customers. Recent growth has occured at the rate of 30 to 60 new connections per year.

The utility expanded the plant in 1997 by increasing the source of supply, adding three new high service pumps to replace pumps that were over thirty years old and increasing the storage facilities.

In 1999, the utility received the "Small Community WTP Award" from the DEP South District. The utility was recognized for high quality of service, continuously well maintained facilities and for meeting all of DEP's chemical and bacteriological requirements.

The utility was granted a rate increase in February 2001 by PSC order number PSC-01-0327-PAA-WU The utility works with the community and publishes articles in the community newsletter to keep customers informed of water issues, rate increases and conservation tips.
