NOTICE

Persons affected by Commission action on certain items on this agenda may be allowed to address the Commission, either informally or by oral argument, when those items are taken up for discussion at this conference. To participate informally, affected persons need only appear at the agenda conference and request the opportunity to address the Commission on an item listed on agenda. Informal participation is not permitted: (1) on dispositive motions and motions for reconsideration; (2) when a recommended order is taken up by the Commission; (3) in a rulemaking proceeding after the record has been closed; or (4) when the Commission considers a post-hearing recommendation on the merits of a case after the close of the record. The Commission allows informal participation at its discretion in certain types of cases (such as declaratory statements and interim rate orders) in which an order is issued based on a given set of facts without hearing.

Issue 1: Should the Commission approve the standard offer contract and related rate schedules filed by FPUC?

Recommendation: Yes. The revised standard offer contracts and related rate schedules conform to all the requirements of Rules 25-17.200 through 25-17.310, F.A.C., and reflect the avoidable costs associated with FPUC's purchased power agreements. Staff recommends that the revised standard offer contracts and related rate schedules filed by FPUC be approved.

Issue 2: Should this docket be closed?

Recommendation: Yes. This docket should be closed upon issuance of a Consummating Order, unless a person whose substantial interests are affected by the Commission's decision files a protest within 21 days of the issuance of the Commission's proposed agency action order. Potential signatories should be aware that, if a timely protest is filed, FPUC's standard offer contract may subsequently be revised.

Issue 1: Should the Commission approve TECO's petition for a four-month extension of Commission approval of the special contract?

Recommendation: Yes, the Commission should approve TECO's petition for a four-month extension of Commission approval of the special contract through and including November 4, 2013. Staff should be authorized to administratively approve a 60-day extension beyond November 4, 2013, if needed.
